

JGANC Scholarship Application Process

APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must have completed the junior year of high school and rank in the upper part of his/her class scholastically.
2. Must enroll at a FOUR year college/university of his/her choice. Community colleges are not eligible.
3. Show a financial need to attend college. Due to our limited number of scholarships, financial need will play a major role in eligibility.
4. Must have outstanding personal character and leadership abilities.
5. Must be a member of the JGANC for at least two years prior to applying.

RULES FOR APPLICATION:

1. Download application from the **www.jganc.com**, complete and mail it to the following address by **10/01/11: P.O. Box 184, San Ramon, CA 94583**
2. Application must be accompanied with a letter from the principal and/or counselor of the applicant's school.
3. A transcript of applicant's grades must be included.
4. A copy of the front page of your family IRS 1040 Income Tax Return with Social Security numbers lined out must be included.

RULES FOR SELECTION:

1. The Scholarship Committee consists of three directors from the JGANC board. The purpose of this committee will be their selection of those members deemed most worthy of grants and their decisions are final.
2. Candidates will be notified on **10/03/11** when to appear before the scholarship committee for their personal interview.
3. **All candidates are required to attend this interview or they will not be considered for a scholarship. Interviews will be conducted on 10/08/11 at The Bridges Golf Club.**
4. The scholarship committee will announce the recipients at the annual Tournament of Champions banquet at **Silverado CC & Resort, Napa on 10/29/11.**
5. Golfing ability is not a criteria in the selection and the applicant need not pursue golf at the collegiate level.

If you fits these requirements, please download the application as soon as possible. Application and all supporting documents must be mailed back to our office by 10/01/11, no exception.

All scholarship recipients and their parents will be invited as our luncheon guests at the *Tournament of Champions* banquet on 10/29/11 at Silverado CC & Resort where the awards are announced at that time.
