



JGANC Scholarship Application Process

APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY:

1. Must have completed the junior year of high school and rank in the upper part of his/her class scholastically.
2. Must enroll at a college/university of his/her choice.
3. Must have outstanding personal character and leadership abilities.
4. Must be a member of the JGANC for at **least two years prior** to applying.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION:

Application must be received by 10/6/26. No exception.

1. Application must be accompanied with a recommendation letter from the principal and/or counselor of the applicant's school.
2. Application must be accompanied with a school transcript.

SUBMITTING APPLICATION:

Application and all supporting documents must be received in the following order in one email:

1. Complete application
2. Letter of recommendation from principal/counselor/coach
3. School Transcript
4. Other extra curriculum or standardized test (optional)

RULES FOR SELECTION:

1. The Scholarship Committee consists of three directors from the JGANC board. The purpose of this committee will be their selection of those members deemed most worthy of grants and their decisions are final.
2. Selected candidates will be notified on **10/8/26** when to appear before the scholarship committee for their personal interview.
3. **All candidates are required to attend this interview or they will not be considered for a scholarship. Interviews will be conducted on Zoom either 10/11/26 or 10/12/26.**
4. The scholarship committee will award the recipients at the annual Tournament of Champions luncheon at **Castlewood Country Club on 11/23/26. Attendance is required, no exception.**
5. Golfing ability is not a criteria in the selection and the applicant need not pursue golf at the collegiate level.

All scholarship recipients and their parents will be invited as our luncheon guests at the *Tournament of Champions* on 11/23/26 at Castlewood Country Club where the awards are announced at that time.

Recipient must be present at the awards banquet to receive the scholarship.
